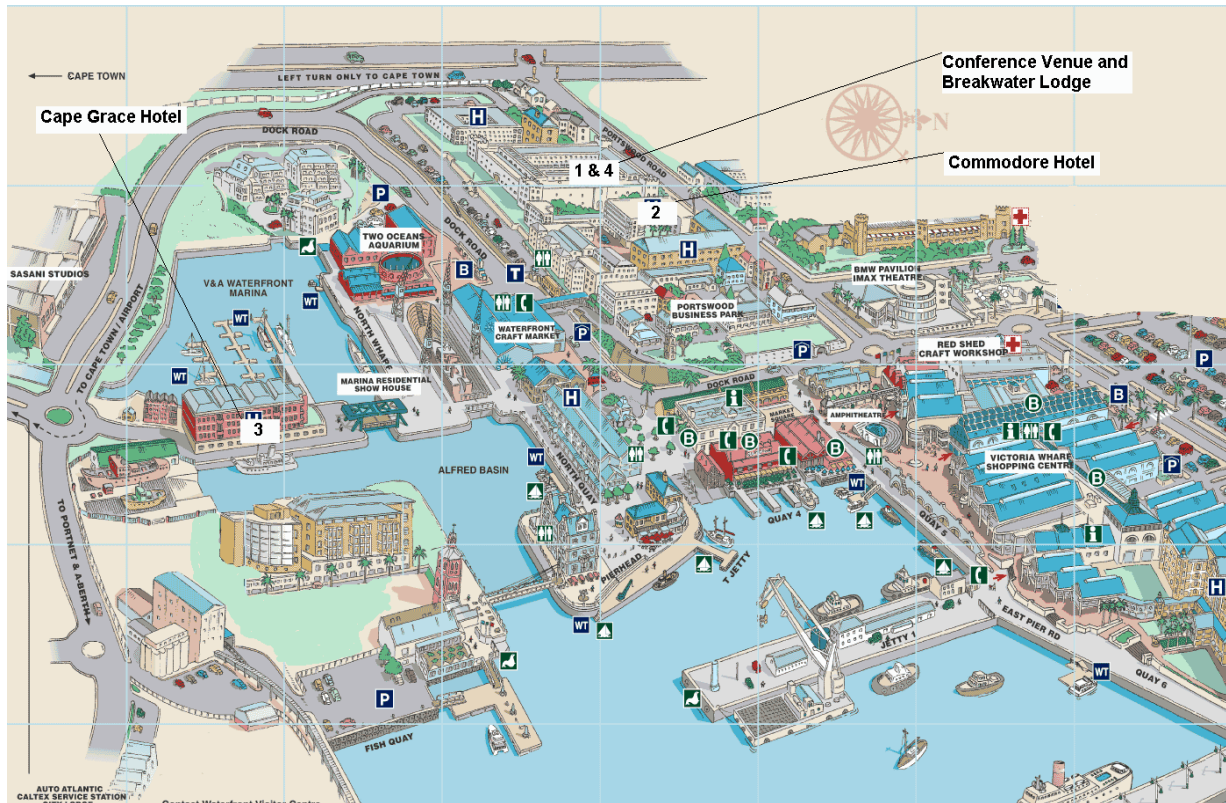

HOTEL INFORMATION



(The numbers below refer to locations numbered on the map)

1. Conference venue: Graduate Business School of the Breakwater campus of the University of Cape Town, Portwood Road, Cape Town. The venue for all sessions except Wednesday morning.

Hotels:

(The hotels are all safe environments with 24-hour security, in the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront area, <http://www.waterfront.co.za/>, about two km from the city centre. The Waterfront is a secure prestige tourist area with its own security patrols and 24-hour surveillance with 100+ CCTV cameras.)

2. Commodore Hotel 4*

Portwood Road, Cape Town. 236 rooms. The **conference hotel** is literally alongside the conference venue. The Commodore opened in 1999 and offers luxury accommodation, attentive and friendly service, and is decorated to a nautical theme appropriate to its location in the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. Rooms have air-conditioning, bath, shower and toilet, multichannel satellite TV, telephone and ISDN lines in each of its rooms, minibar, tea/coffee making facilities, and 24-hour room service. There is a swimming pool and gymnasium with sauna onsite. A great rate for a luxury hotel; single occupancy Rand 870 per night, twin/double occupancy Rand 1280 per night. Full breakfast included.

3. Cape Grace Hotel 5*

West Quay Road, Cape Town. 122 rooms. Part of the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront development with water on three sides, and views of Table Mountain, the yacht marina, and the harbour. This is a modern deluxe boutique hotel, family run, with understated style and elegance, voted 'Best Hotel in the World' in 2000 by Condé Nast Traveler readers. Spacious rooms with French windows, air-conditioning, telephone and modem connection, bath, shower and toilet, multi-channel satellite TV, tea/coffee making facilities, minibar, and 24-hour room service. Wine tasting in the Library before dinner, cocktail bar, whisky bar with the best selection of whiskies in the southern hemisphere, sun patio and pool. 10 minutes easy walk from the Conference Venue. Rooms: Rand 3700 per night, single or double occupancy. Full breakfast included. <http://www.capegrace.com/>

4. Breakwater Lodge

Breakwater Lodge, Portsworld Road, Cape Town. 300 rooms. Comfortable inexpensive graduate student accommodation operated by Protea Hotels, linked directly to the conference venue (once a nineteenth century prison but thoroughly modernised!). The site overlooks the bay, has views of Table Mountain, and the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront is on the doorstep. There is a 24-hour reception and all rooms have TV with local stations, telephone and tea/coffee making facilities. Choice of private ensuite bath / shower / toilet and slightly larger room **or** room sharing toilet / shower with one other room. Single room with ensuite facilities: Rand 533 per person per night. Single room with shared facilities: Rand 351 per person per night. Twin/double with ensuite facilities: Rand 682. Twin/double with shared facilities: Rand 500. Full breakfast included.
