International Association of Law Libraries Annual Report of the Secretary 2009-2010

This year was an election year. At the end of January 2010, the Nominations Committee sent to the Secretary notification of the proposed slate of candidates for the officers and members for the new Board of Directors for the term 2010-2013.

In February the Secretary mailed the notice to all members, informing them that for a term of sixty days after the notice was mailed, the members had the opportunity to submit names of candidates for any office, providing the petition was signed by ten or more members of the Association. Information on the election was also circulated through the website and the Listserv. The Secretary did not receive any petitions and as stated by article VII of the Constitution, the names submitted by the Nominations Committee were acclaimed without ballot.
